










#### On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Christmas, my true love sent to me .....

For Oliver that means Mario Kart with his brother and sister, but for Tori and Charlie it means putting the past few months behind them.


Will this Christmas drive the Spring family apart or start to put them back together?





Because Will is not the ordinary boy he always thought he was. He is the last of the Old Ones and the power to vanquish the evil magic of the Dark lies within him.



But by the next morning, they've gone – taking Oskar with them.


Fearful for his safety, Mila and her sisters set out to bring Oskar back – even it means going north, crossing frozen wild-lands to find a way past an eternal winter.


