Focus on analysing performance – NOT the story

- Acting: voice (pitch, pace, tone), movement, gesture, facial expression
- **Key moments:**
- My Shot → ambition, impulsiveness
- Satisfied → movement and storytelling
- Wait For It → patience, control, restraint (contrast with Hamilton's impulsiveness)
- The Room Where It Happens → power & staging
- Who Tells Your Story → emotion and ensemble
- Always explain: WHAT → HOW → EFFECT

Component 3: Design & Staging

Know how design creates meaning:

- Lighting → colour, brightness, mood
- Set → rotating stage, levels, space
- Costume → status, character
- Sound → music, volume, atmosphere
- Link everything to audience impact

Component 1: Devising Theatre

Understand the process:

- Stimulus → Ideas → Improvisation → Rehearsal → Performance → Evaluation

Component 1: Drama Techniques

- Freeze frame

- Direct address
- Slow motion
- Flashback
