REMEMBRANCE DAY




Remembrance Day is on the 11th November and marks the day World War One ended, at 11am on the 11th day of the 11th month, in 1918.

Students will have access to a wide range of books on the theme of War to celebrate and remember those who fought and gave their lives in the past.



















ANTI BULLYING WEEK - 14TH - 18TH NOVEMBER

During this week students will have the opportunity to borrow books focusing on Bullying.


















Awards are achieved once students have read the number of words below. To gain these words, the quiz must be passed:
