Mock Assessment:  
Pupils provided with a mock brief for Component 3



End of Year



**Respond to a Variety of Briefs:**  
Pupils provided with different set task briefs and respond individually by researching genres and making note on how to meet the requirements of the brief and the target audience.

**1 Song 3 Styles:**  
Pupils select a song, they are given three new styles from Component 1 and a summary of the stylistic features. Pupils create their own short song in which the same song has been worked in to three different styles.



**Draw a Genre from a Hat – Group work**  
Pupils choose an extract from a song and re-work the excerpt into a different style of music



Pupils given a brief to create a chorus based on a song and a different genre for a specific audience (group work)

**Component 3 – Responding to a Music Brief**  
AO1: Understand how to respond to a music brief  
AO2: Select and apply musical skills in response to a music brief  
AO3: Present a final product in response to a music brief  
AO4: Comment on the creative process and outcome in response to a music brief

- Performing stylistically accurate cover versions
- Creating original music using existing stylistic frameworks and traits
- Stylistic use of DAW and associated hardware to create an original piece of music from a given starting point.
